Biala Wind Farm is committed to achieving proactive and transparent communication with the local community.

PROJECT BACKGROUND

Biala Wind Farm was recently purchased from Newtricity Developments, who originally owned the project. A submission for a Development Approval was made in 2015 and approval was granted in April 2017 by the NSW Minister for Planning. The project and all consents were sold to BJCE Australia in September 2017.

We aim to begin construction of the 31 turbine wind farm in mid 2018 with electricity being generated in the second quarter of 2019.

The planned wind farm will have an installed capacity of approximately 100MW producing enough electricity for approximately 46,000 typical homes on an average day of wind.

BJCE Australia already has a 75% interest in the nearby 73 turbine Gullen Range Wind Farm and 10MW Gullen Solar Farm.

Once operational, Biala Wind Farm will contribute approximately \$90,000 per year into a fund for community projects.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Our team will be available throughout the construction and ongoing operation of Biala Wind Farm.

Community activity will commence with one-on-one meetings to provide an overview of the development to our immediate neighbours and to invite feedback. As the project gets underway there will be regular updates and other outreach activities including community information and wind farm open days. PROPOSED PROJECT TIMELINE

December 2017 – May 2018

Construction planning including development of Fauna, Heritage and Traffic Management Plans for approval of NSW Department of Planning.

May 2018 – July 2018

Upgrade works to Range Road and Kialla Road.

June 2018 – March 2019

Construction of wind farm tracks, underground electrical cabling and wind turbine foundations.

October 2018 – April 2019

Delivery and erection of wind turbines.

February – June 2019

Final commissioning and commencement of operation.

The location of the Biala Wind Farm is shown in red below. Electricity from the wind farm will be transmitted to the electricity grid via underground cables which are shown in purple.
