Crookwell Devils secure much-needed funds from Biala Wind Farm

Crookwell Devils senior and ladies rugby league team has secured \$5,000 in funding from Biala Wind Farm allowing both teams to run out this season in brand new jerseys.

Biala Wind Farm is the newest project from BJCE Australia who also own 75% of the nearby Gullen Range Wind Farm and Gullen Solar Farm. The new project is located approximately 8km east of Biala and 14.5km south west of Crookwell and is expected to have an installed capacity of about 100MW, producing enough electricity for approximately 46,000 typical homes on an average day of wind.

Project Manager for Biala Wind Farm, Tim Mead, welcomed the sponsorship request: "BJCE Australia believes in investing in the communities where we operate and grassroots football brings huge benefits to communities in many different ways. We're proud to be able to provide some financial support to enable the viability of the club and to ensure the senior teams have the uniforms they need."

The Crookwell Devils Rugby League Club initially contacted BJCE Australia in 2016 for sponsorship. Today BJCE Australia is a major long-term sponsor and supporter of the club.

Jayne Selmes, Secretary of Crookwell Senior Rugby League said, "Without the funding from Biala Wind Farm this year, our Club would certainly have found it difficult to operate. We cannot thank BJCE Australia enough for their ongoing generous support."

Over the weekend, the senior men's team secured a victory in the George Tooke against Binalong with an easy win of 42 – 4 and our Ladies League Tag was also victorious with a 52 – 4 win against the Binalong Girls. This weekend the Devils take on all three Harden sides at Harden's McLean Oval on Saturday afternoon.
