Primary Contractors Announced

We've made a big step forward this month toward construction of the Biala Wind Farm. We have appointed the construction contractors who will complete the work. Three different contractors have been awarded contracts.

Consolidated Power Projects Australia or CPP will complete the electrical works, including installation of the underground high voltage cables on the wind farm and across to BJCE's existing substation at Gullen Range Wind Farm. They will also extend the existing substation so that the electricity from Biala Wind Farm can be passed on to the electricity grid. CPP has completed the electrical works on 35 wind farm projects and 19 wind farm substations. We are confident they will do an excellent job.

CATCON will complete the civil works on the wind farm site. This includes upgrading site junctions on Grabben Gullen road, new unsealed tracks to each of the wind turbines and a concrete foundation for each wind turbine.

The wind turbines will be supplied and maintained by Goldwind, the world's largest wind turbine manufacturer in 2018. Goldwind turbines are also installed at our Gullen Range Wind Farm. Goldwind is headquartered in Beijing and the Australian arm has grown rapidly, employing 212 people nationally. Goldwind Australia employ fourteen locally based maintenance technicians at Gullen Range Wind Farm and when Biala Wind Farm construction is complete, this crew will be expanded to maintain the Biala wind turbines.

Construction of Biala Wind Farm will take approximately 18-months to complete. It is expected the wind farm will commence exporting energy to the national grid in July 2020 and will be completed in November 2020.

Mobile Phone Booster

We're aware mobile phone reception is a community priority in Grabben Gullen and surrounding areas. Mobile phone reception is not something we know a lot about, but we understand it is a complicated issue to resolve.

We've agreed to fund the permanent installation of a mobile phone booster at the Albion Hotel in Grabben Gullen and the Grabben Gullen Hall to enhance Telstra reception in the village. The booster had already been installed by another company as a free trial, but somebody needed to pay the bill in order for it to remain permanently. We know this doesn't solve the mobile phone problem, but hopefully it helps a little bit. We thank the Grabben Gullen Community Progress Association and the Albion Hotel for their help with this community initiative.

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Range Road Upgrade

Range Road upgrade work is still underway. So far work has been concentrating on the section of road closest to Grabben Gullen, with 25% now completed. We have now replaced two culverts across Humes Creek. Bitumen sealing of the first two kilometres of the Range Road upgrade will commence in early July.

The upgrade is required under the Biala Wind Farm Development Approval Conditions of Consent and will provide a new and improved road surface, between Grabben Gullen and the Kialla Road junction, for the community for many years to come.

About the Project

Biala Wind Farm is located approximately 6km south of Grabben Gullen on Grabben Gullen Road. It is owned by BJCE Australia, who also own Gullen Range Wind Farm and Gullen Solar Farm. Biala Wind Farm is proposed to have 31 turbines and was awarded a Development Approval in April 2017 by the NSW Planning Assessment Commission. It will connect to the electricity grid via underground electricity cables from the Gullen Range Wind Farm substation at Bannister.
