Green Energy Shire - our contribution

In 2022, our wind farms made a valuable green energy contribution to the Upper Lachlan Shire. Gullen Range Wind Farm powered an average of 74,428 homes per day and Biala Wind Farm powered 56,142 homes per day. According to recent census data, Upper Lachlan Shire has 4,589 homes and Goulburn Mulwaree has 14,739. In 2022 we produced enough energy to power more than 6 times the combined residential requirements of both council areas added together! Your support is a major factor in this achievement and we thank you.

Since 2016, over 80 homes have become more energy efficient through Program grants provided by us for things like solar panels or solar hot water systems.
